That all men by their presents that we Lawrence Mc^e Meanus and Elizabeth Mc^e Meanus the wife of the aforesaid, Lawrence Mc^e Meanus both of the County of Macoupin and State of Illinois, for and in Consideration and use and benefit of the Philoth Church of the United Baptist holding the doctrine of Election and General Judgment and Baptism by immersion as the only proper mode, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted and donated, and by their presents do donate and confirm unto the Said Philoth Church, a certain tract of land or lot of ground lying and being, and being in the Said County of Macoupin and State aforesaid, it being Township N^o Eleven North, Range N^o One West, Section One, of the third principal Meridian, it being in the West Half of the South East quarter and lying and being in the North West Corner of said lot, and bounded as follows to wit, beginning at the North West Corner, running South twenty poles, ^{to a stake} thence East twenty poles, ^{to a stake} thence North twenty poles to said stake, thence West to the beginning, containing two Acres and one half more or less.

To Have and To Hold together with all and singular the rights and profits thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining to the only proper use and benefit of Said Church And we the Said Lawrence Mc^e Meanus and Elizabeth his wife, for ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, will warrant and forever defend the above described tract of land to the Said Church, against the Claim or Claims of all persons whatsoever and against all lawful Claims what soever.
