 tract or parcel of land ^{known} and described on the plat of said town
 of Woodburn County & State aforesaid known and designated as lot
 No. one and a half No. three of Woodburn To have and to hold the same
 described granted premises unto the assignees and assigns unto the said
 Joseph Walker James Long and Daniel Lubell and to their
 successors in office to the sole use of the Woodburn Baptist Church
 forever and the said B. St. Edwards and Eliza his wife the
 Adams and Rebecca his wife for the consideration

above named the said grants from

whosoever will warrant and freely defend the within
