perform and discharge the trust and office of guardian unto the said minors, and that in and by all things
according to law : and shall render a plain and true account of *their* said guardianship up-
on oath, and all and singular such estate as shall come to *their* hand and possession by virtue here-
of, and of the profits and improvements of the same, so far as the law will charge *them* therewith
(when *they* shall be thereunto lawfully required) and shall pay and deliver what and so much of the
